



## American Hebrew Academy Merit Scholarship Application

The American Hebrew Academy offers several merit based scholarships to prospective students. No student may receive more than one merit scholarship. Need based financial assistance may be granted in addition to a merit scholarship. Those awarded with an American Hebrew Academy Honor Society scholarship, are ineligible for additional scholarships or financial assistance.

Please select the scholarship for which you are applying. Candidates may not apply for more than one scholarship listed below.

- The Sabbah Scholars** - A scholarship of up to \$5,000 a year will be given to students who exemplify outstanding ability in the areas of academics, Jewish studies, athletics, and community involvement
- The Shavitz Scholars** – A scholarship of up to \$5,000 a year will be given to students who epitomize outstanding dedication in the area of Jewish studies and Jewish communal life.
- The Bernard & Gloria Robinson Math Scholarship** – For students who demonstrate outstanding achievement in mathematics, a scholarship of up to \$2,500 will be awarded.
- Philip Cohen Memorial Scholarship for the Arts** – A scholarship with an award of up to \$2,000 will be presented to students with an aptitude and talent in the Arts.
- Lawrence Cohen Scholars** – Designated specifically for Guilford and/or Forsyth County, North Carolina residents, this scholarship, based on financial need and merit, awards up to \$1,500 per student to fulfill their dream of an Academy education.

Each scholarship awarded will be used to offset tuition costs and is renewable each year enrolled provided the student maintains at least an 82.0 G.P.A. and behavioral integrity.
